whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 16th day of Jan'y 1796

Halling to mind the mortality of my Body & knowing that it is appointed all men once to die I make &
ordain this my last will & Testament in manner & form following that is to say I give & command
My soul to the hands of Almighty God who gave it & my Body to the earth to be buried a Christian
manner at the direction of my Executrix hereafter mentioned not Doubting but at the General Resurrection
I shall receive the same by the mighty power of God & as touching such worldly Estate as I hath plan
the Almighty God to Bless me I give & dispose of the same in the manner & form following
Item I give & bequeath to my son Matthew Howell to him & his heirs forever my two Negro girls
Dicks & King. Item I give & bequeath to my son in law James Ward to him & his heirs forever
two Acres of land back to Tom. Item I leave to my Grandson William Shinner the Lands I
brought of Thomas Shinner as well as appear by deed from said Shinner one feather bed & furniture
my young Servt Marry also my Negro boy Dick my Negro woman Sallie also my two Negro
boys & all to him & his heirs forever lawfully begotten of his body with all their Dower in case of th
said Shinner die before that time lawfully begotten their my desire is that what Land he may be
equally divided among all my children.

Item I give & bequeath to my Daughter Paternia Pace to her & her heirs Twenty Shillings
 Item I give to my Daughter Jane Brulee to her & her heirs Twenty Shillings
 Item I give & bequeath to Eliza Pitman who married my Daughter Sarah Howell the sum of
 Ten Shillings. Item I give & bequeath to my son Matthew Howell & James Ward each one
 Bed & furniture. Item I give & bequeath the Balance or remainder of my Estate not hereby
 given away to be Equally divided among my before mentioned Children & my Grandson & their
 to them & their heirs forever & lastly I do hereby Constitution & appoint my son Matthew Howell
 & James Ward my whole & sole Executors of this my last will & Testament In witness whereof
 I have hereunto set my hand & seal the day & year above written

 the Tract of Land that I bought of William Scott & Nasor Tipton, beginning in Dominic Branch
 at the Crossing place where said Tipton formerly lived then along a line of marshy土 ^土 & water the
 path goes to Josiah Wilmer Line including all the land from the said Line of Marshy土
 between Dominic Wilmer Line & Captain Smiths Line together with the mill standing upon
 Land also one Negroe boy called Caesar one sugroe man called Frank one bay mare called
 Mary & her colt & one other colt called Mark Anthony Bridle & saddle the Bed & furniture
 five head of Cows & calves Now in case my son Whitmell Should not live to the age of Twenty
 one year or die without issue then ahd in that case it is my will & desire that the said Land
 given to him be the property of my son Josiah

Item I give & bequeath unto my son Josiah Cotton to him his heirs & assigns forever my
 Land of plantation in Scotland Creek, it being the Land that I bought of Richard Bonnet called
 the Islands, also one Negroe boy called Abram, five cows & calves one bed & furniture & in case my
 son Josiah Should not live to the age of twenty one year or die without issue it is my will & desire
 the Land given to him be the property of my son Whitmell

Item I give & bequeath unto my son James Cotton to him his heirs & assigns forever a part of my
 tract of Land on the Cypress Swamp, beginning at a Cypress said swamp a corner then
 Between William Baker Land and mine running up the run of said swamp to the Head then
 along the Little Cahaki Swamp then down Cahaki Swamp to the first deep Branch that
 may be in Cahaki at a black Gum then up the said branch by a Line of Marshy土 & water
 backing in the pasture from thence by a line of marshy土 to a Stake in Baker Line from
 thence to the first Stake, also one Negroe boy called Davy, five cows & calves one bed & furniture
 if my son James should not live to the age of Twenty one year or die without issue it is my will &
 desire that the said Land be the property of my son John Cotton

Item I give & bequeath unto my son Robert Cotton to him his heirs & assigns forever my Land an
 plantation on the run in Edgemont County it being the Land that I bought of Daniel Woodard also
 one Negroe boy called Ben one Bed & furniture now in case my son Robert Should not live to the
 age of Twenty one year or die without issue then in that case it is my will & desire that the aforesaid
