Short History of Howell and Johnson Lineage.

Many years ago came the Howell
family from North Carolina, who
settled in Georgia. Mather Howell
Sr. and wife, whose maiden name
was Ascension Leavenough and their
five sons, Mather, McKinney, Isaac,
Joseph and William; only one daughter,
Nancy who married Kelms, and was
mother of James, Martha and Antoinet
Kelms. As this family lived in the
Counfordville precinct our family saw
them frequently. I remember them all
quite well, especially James, and Martha.
Cousin Jim married Menerva Kilsman
and cousin Martha married Bert Alexander.
Antoinette married Dr. Nicholson.
Cousin Martha's last husband was Mr.
Davenport who lived in south Ga.

My grandfather, McKinney, married
Mary Johnson, daughter of
John Johnson and wife's maiden name
was Ashfeldt - German extraction.

The Johnson lineage
says this is not so &
that the Johnsons came
from Scotland originally.
Mary (Polly) Johnson Howell
has the hair.

My Howell grand father's brothers, ~~Wm.~~
and Isaac soon went to Alabama
and William changed to some other
state. Isaac used to visit my father
and was an exceedingly entertaining
and gentlemanly visitor. He married
a sister of Alfred Davis.

My grandmother, Mary Johnson Howell
